

High Definition

Fabric by Faye Burgos
Quilt by Vicki Bellino of Bloom Creek

Finished Size: 49" x 49"

Fabric Requirements:

1¼" yards of the square block print – 2230-0112
1 yard of Strip-It – 2231-0112
1 yard of red (includes binding) – 2051-0111
(Gallery in Red)

Cutting:

From the Square Block Print,
Cut a 36" x 36" square, centering six squares
widthwise and lengthwise. (Note: Open up the
fabric to full width when cutting this piece.)

From the Strip-It,
Cut four strips 6½" by width of fabric; beginning and ending with a black rectangle, cross-cut each strip at 37½"

From the Red Print,
Cut four strips, 1¼" by width of fabric; cross-cut two strips at 36" and two strips at 37½"
Cut four squares, 6½" x 6½" (border)
Prepare 16 squares, 2" x 2" and 13 squares, 1" x 1" for fusible or hand appliqué
Cut five strips, 2" x width of fabric for binding (or your preferred width)

Making the Quilt:

1. Alternating 1" and 2" red squares, appliqué in place as shown in diagram, placing red squares on point.
2. With right sides together, stitch a 1¼"x 36" red strip to the top and bottom of the quilt, pressing to red. Repeat for sides, using the 37½" strips.
3. Stitch a 6½" x 37½" Strip-It border piece to the top and bottom of the quilt, pressing to border. Stitch a 6½" red square to each end of the two remaining Strip-It borders and stitch to each side of the quilt.
4. Quilt as desired and bind with the 2" red print strips.
